
Newborn Lifestyle Session

Q: I've never done a professional portrait shoot before. What can I expect?

A: A portrait session with me is all about capturing your unique personality and style in a relaxed and comfortable environment. We'll work together to create beautiful images that reflect the real you.

Q: Can you help me with posing? I'm not sure how to pose for photos.

A: Absolutely! I'll provide guidance and direction throughout the entire process to ensure you feel comfortable and look your best. We'll explore different poses and angles to capture your most flattering angles. I'm all about movement that create those real, authentic moments - so you're going to have fun with it, too.

Q: What should I wear for my portrait session?

A: Above all else - wearing something that makes you feel confident and comfortable is the most important. Once your session is booked, you will receive a Look Book Outfit Guide to help you decide on outfits that will photograph best. (Pssst...neutrals are always best!)

Q: Will my photos be posted publicly on your site or social media?

A: As a small business, one of the best ways for me to grow and reach new clients is by sharing your beautiful images in my marketing material. However, I respect your privacy and allow each client to decide whether or not they want their photos displayed publicly. Just let me know ahead of time.

Q: Will you Photoshop my images to hide any unwanted spots, wrinkles, etc?

A: Minor edits will be made to all of your images, but I believe our imperfections are what make us beautiful & unique. If there are specific edits you want, these will be charged according to the number and complexity of edits.

Q: Where will the portrait session take place? Do you have a studio, or should I choose a location? A: I'm all about nature, so my favorite place to take your photos is in the great outdoors, typically at golden hour if weather allows. I have a list of suggestions depending upon what environment you're looking for, and I'm happy to discuss any ideas you may have. I also offer studio sessions. However, it's important to note that the studio I use is rented, and therefore, there is a rental fee associated with this type of session. This fee covers the cost of the studio rental and ensures that we have access to a professional and well-equipped space for your portrait session.

Q: How many photos can we actually expect to see in the proofing gallery?

A: While each session is different, you can expect to see all "good" images from your session, edited and retouched beautifully in your proofing gallery. This is where I'll walk you through creating your favorites list, and if you love more than the amount of images included in your chosen package, you have the option to purchase more!

Q: How soon will I receive the final edited photos?

A: You can expect to receive a sneak peek of edited photos within a few days of the session. The full proofing gallery of edited images will be delivered to you within 2-3 weeks, depending on the editing workload and package you choose.

Q: Can we have the RAW images?

A: RAW images are the unprocessed, "raw" data captured by the camera sensor. While they contain all the information from the shoot, they are not the final, polished product that you see in the edited and retouched images I provide. As a professional photographer, I take pride in delivering a complete product that represents my expertise and your investment in my services. Sharing RAW files would undermine the value of my finished work.

Q: What if it rains on the day of our outdoor session?

A: In the event of inclement weather, we can reschedule the session for another date that works for both of us. Your deposit will still be good towards our rescheduled date.

Q: Can I bring props or accessories to incorporate into the photos?

A: Absolutely! Bringing props or accessories can add a personal touch to your photos and help tell your unique story. Let me know what you have in mind, and we'll work together to incorporate them into the session.

Q: How do I book a portrait session with you?

A: Booking a portrait session is easy! Simply reach out to me via email or phone to discuss your package choice and schedule a date for the session. A \$100 nonrefundable deposit and contract is required to book. I'll guide you through the booking process and answer any additional questions you may have. Can't wait to hear from you!
